### ORDER


The appellant has preferred an appeal aggrieved by the non-making available the information asked by him under the Right to Information Act, 2005 vide application dtd. 23.4.2009. The Appeal is mainly preferred for non-receipt of the following information :-

- A) As per Circular issued by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board bearing No. MPCB/EB/K-A-04/B-1107 dtd. 11.10.2007 in respect of the Seniority List of the Head Accountant, certain objections were received by the Board in respect of the temporary Seniority List. The copies of such objections were asked to be supplied by the Appellant.
- Shri. S.R. Banate , Sr. Administrative Officer, has made available the copies of the objections received to the Seniority list of the Head Accountant (Total 4 objections) vide letter dtd. 16.6.2009. The Appellant was asked about the receipt of such information and he had acknowledged the receipt thereof.
- B) The Appellant further asked the information as to whether final Seniority list has been prepared or not?

- Shri. S.R. Banate, Sr. Administrative Officer vide letter dtd. 16.6.2009 has specifically communicated that the temporary Seniority List has not yet finalized. Shri. S.R. Banate, Sr. Administrative Officer also communicated to the Information Officer to recover the typing expenditure / Xeroxing expenditure from the Appellant. Since, the information is not given in the stipulated period of time, the expenditure cannot be recovered.

The Appeal is accordingly disposed off.
