OFFICE ORDER NO. 16 of 2021

Sub: Facilitation of COVID-19 temporary establishments for grant of BMW authorization and Monitoring of Covid-19 waste -reg

Ref: VC of Member Secretary with HODs on 27.04.2021 at 12.30 pm


In view of the current second surge of COVID-19 pandemic Member Secretary discussed various issues to ensure timely response and expeditious disposal of MPCB legal permissions to COVID-19 related establishments.

It is decided to grant Temporary Authorisations to "COVID-19 Temporary HCEs" (Covid Care Centres, Vaccination Centres and Pathology Sample Collection Centres). In order to facilitate the expeditious process of grant of BMW authorisation following protocol shall be applicable:

- 1) The authorised person of COVID-19 HCE shall apply for BMW authorisation through online portal in prescribed format. Only Authorisation fees shall be applicable as per no. of beds as per Env. Department notification dated 10.04.2003.
- 2) SRO shall inspect the facility and ensure following compliances:
 - i) BNH Certificate granted by District Collector or Municipal Commissioner as evidenced by official Order in the name of HCE/ Applicant.
 - ii) Valid Membership certificate of BMW CTF facility authorised by MPCB.
 - iii) Provision of onsite Temporary waste storage facility for COVID and Non Covid waste as per CPCB guidelines.
 - iv) Arrangement for Treatment & Disposal of Effluent/ Sewage without adverse impact on surrounding environment.
- 3) Upon satisfying above compliances, Regional Officer, MPCB of concerned jurisdiction shall grant BMW Authorisation in prescribed format irrespective of No. Beds/ No. Vaccinations per day and No. of Pathology Samples to be collected per Day. However the same shall be mentioned in Authorisation granted.

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- 4) All such authorisation shall remain valid for One Year from the date of issue. In case facility is to be operated beyond one year HCE shall make application 90 days before expiry through online portal.
- 5) HCE shall report closure of the facility forthwith to SRO concerned
