HOD Remarks :

1. Applied for Consent to establish (Expansion).
2. Application received at SRO Nagpur-II on 01/10/2011 and at HQ 05/11/2011.
3. Textile industry involving Twisting, drawing and thermoset processing.
4. Existing industry is having full fledged ETP and JVS results are within prescribed limits.
5. Land available for disposal of effluent is 130 Acres.
6. Bag house provided as an Air Pollution Control equipment and mechanical dust collector as stand by arrangement.
7. The site of proposed expansion is @500 meters from river Kanhan.
8. The application was discussed in CAC dtd 07/12/2011 & SCN for refusal of consent was issued as industry is not satisfying RRZ policy.
9. Industry replied that ind is in existence since 1986 i.e prior to RRZ policy.
10. Industry requested for grant of Consent as no IE is generated.
11. Industry is not confirming RRZ policy.
12. Industry has not submitted proper format of no increase in Pollution load.
13. Hence we may be refuse consent.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for grant of Consent to Establish for construction of residential, office & Hotel buildings on 21/09/2011.
2. Query letter issued to industry on 18.10.2011.
3. Application for grant of consent to establish in a prescribed format received at SRO-Mumbai-III on 21.09.2011 and received at HQ on 23.11.2011.
4. This case was transferred from R.O. (HQ) Section on 30.11.2011 and received at A.S. (Tech.) Section on 3/12/2011.
5. From the Consent processing report, it was observed that the applicant has started construction activities without obtaining Environmental Clearance and Consent to Establish.
6. The application was placed before CAC meeting held on 15/12/2011. It was decided to issue directions to stop work. Accordingly the stop work directions were issued for starting construction activities without obtaining Environmental Clearance and Consent to Establish vide letter No. MPCB/AS(T)/SW/TB/B-7306 dtd. 23/12/2011 to the project proponent.
7. The firm has submitted reply to the directions on 25/01/2011 that they have obtained Environmental Clearance in June 2011 in compliance of the EIA Notification. Also, industry has requested to grant Consent to Establish.
8. Consent to Establish may be granted subject to Condition of compliance with the conditions of Env. Clearance and submission of Bank Guarantee of Rs. 5 Lakhs with validity upto 2 years towards assurance of compliance of the conditions of the Consent to Establish after obtaining required consent fees and delay charges as per revised G.R. dated 25.08.11 and as per Board policy.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for grant of **consent to Establish (Expansion)** in existing plant for Electricity Generation- 5 MW by using low grade coal.
2. Application received at SRO on 21.12.2009 and at HQ on 08.03.2010.
3. Existing consent to Establish is for waste heat recovery based captive power plant of 25 MW. The industry has obtained Environmental Clearance from Maharashtra Govt. for the same.
4. The proposed plant requires to obtain Environment Clearance, as per EIA Notification, 2006 and amendment dtd. 19/01/2009.
5. The said project is in MIDC Ghugus area. MoEF vide Office Memorandum dtd. 13/01/2010, imposed the **temporary restriction on development of projects in this area**. The said moratorium has been further extended upto 31.03.2012.
6. The effluent generated from the said activity is 225 CMD, which will be recycled in rotary cooler of DRI Plant (150 CMD) & for ash quenching/ sprinklers (80 CMD) and remaining will be utilized for gardening purpose.
7. Proposed to provide ESP for AFBC boiler.
8. Fly ash generated will be sent to cement/brick manufacturers
9. RO/SRO recommended the case for grant of consent to Establish with the condition of obtaining Environmental Clearance as per EIA Notification.
10. The case was **discussed during CAC meeting held on 19.10.2011** and it was decided Consent shall be refused at this stage by following the due procedure due to moratorium imposed by MoEF vide office memorandum dtd. 27.09.2011.
11. Industry has submitted the reply on 04.01.2012 on the SCN for refusal of consent issued by the Board, wherein mentioned that the they have applied for consent (18.12.2009) before the imposition of Moratorium in 13.01.2010. Industry has requested to review the application for grant of consent or **keep the application pending till the moratorium is removed**.

MoEF vide Office Memorandum dtd. 13/01/2010, imposed the **temporary restriction** on development of projects in area (Tadali & Ghugus) with CEPI score above 70 and projects **which are in pipeline for Environmental Clearance would be returned to the project proponents**. The said **moratorium has been extended upto 31.03.2012**.

12. The file was referred to Sr. L.O. and he has recommended that application may not be considered at this stage due to temporary restriction on consideration of development projects in clusters/areas by MoEF vide its letter dtd. 27.09.2011.

- Earlier the case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 15.12.2011 and it was decided to resubmit the case before CAC after obtaining compliance report from RO reg additional land acquisition for disposal of treated effluent, BG status, distance certificate, JVS reports, incineration details within 15 days.
- Accordingly compliance report recd from RO Pune on this point. (copy enclosed) Distance certificate of competent authority dated 17/02/2005 is attached. 8 acre land is available, which seems to be marginally inadequate @ 20 m³/acre. JVS results are marginally exceeding the consented limits.
