- Previous consent was valid up to 30/09/2010
- Industrial Effluent Generation is NIL
- Domestic effluent generation is 27 CMD for which provided sewage treatment plant.
- Industry has provided air pollution control system
- RO Pune has issued SCN to industry 23/12/2011 for non compliances.
- RO Pune recommended for renewal of consent after receipt of satisfactory reply form the industry
- The case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 31/01/2012.it was decided to issue SCN to industry
- Industry submitted the reply on dated 08/02/2012 to Minutes of meeting of CAC
- We may renew the consent for period up to 30/09/2013
- We may place the consent application before CAC for further consideration.

HOD Remarks :

1. Applied for 1st Consent to operate for Phase-I, 2 x 660 = 1320 MW power generation coal base thermal power plant.
2. Board has granted consent to establish for Phase-I vide letter dated 11.09.2008 for the period up to commissioning of the unit.
3. Environment Clearance accorded by MoEF, GOI vide letter dated 29.05.2008.
4. Capital investment of the industry is Rs.6560 Crores. Consent fee of Rs.1,31,20,000/- paid for the validity period up to 30.11.2012..
5. Industrial Effluent is 720 CMD, Cooling Tower Blow down – 13776 CMD, DM Plant effluent is 480 CMD & Domestic Effluent is 480 CMD.
6. Discussed in CAC meeting held on 23.01.2012 and it was decided to issue show cause notice for refusal of consent as industry has not installed pollution control system and non-compliance of conditions stipulated in consent to establish.
7. Show cause notice issued to industry vide letter dated 3.2.2012.
8. SRO, Bhandara has submitted the present status report vide letter dated 19.1.2012 received on 25.01.2012.
9. Industry has submitted the reply of show cause notice vide letter dated 4.2.2012.

As per the reply to the show cause notice received from the industry on 09.2.2012 stating that most of the work such as opacity meter AAQM, Air pollution control to Coal crushers, ash dyke pipeline, S.T.P. Etc will be completed by 15.3.2012.

We may call the fresh inspection report towards installation of various pollution control measures from SRO, Bhandara before granting consent to operate.

HOD Remarks:

1. As the Industry is located 300 meters from Notified river Patalganga. (A-II Class), Case is referred to RRZ Committee on 17.01.2012 for taking further decision in the matter.
2. This case was discussed in the CAC meeting held on 23.01.2012 and it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of amendment in consent for not complying RRZ policy, 2009.
3. Industry has submitted reply to SCN vide letter dtd.08.02.2012 stating that effluent will not be generated from the proposed expansion and they have provided bag house to control air pollution. Also, submitted that no H.W. will be generated from this activity. Industry has requested to grant amendment of consent to operate
4. Not recommended for grant of amendment in consent to operate.

1. Applied for consent to Establish.
2. Application received at Sub Regional Office, Nanded on 20/11/2010 and received at HQ on 01/04/2011.
3. It is Hydro Electric Power project of 25 MW
4. Requires EC, which is not obtained.
5. Indl Eff – 2243 CMD as tail water. Dom Eff – 8.0 CMD for which industry proposes to provide septic tank and soak pit.
6. SRO has recommend the case for grant of consent to Establish.
7. Additional fees of Rs. 583000/- is to be recovered from industry as per new fees GR.
8. We may grant consent to Establish, subject to EC before operate.
9. The case was discussed in CAC dated 15/12/2011 and it was decided to grant the consent to establish.
10. Letter and Show Cause Notice dated 21/12/2011 and 13/01/2012 respectively were issued to the industry for the submission of additional consent fees as per new fees GR dated 25/08/2011.
11. Industry submitted their reply vide letter dated 18/01/2012 and stated that they have submitted demand note of additional consent fees for approval to Executive Director, Godavari Marathwada Irrigation Development Corporation, Aurangabad, the Higher Office.
12. Till date the fees are not received from the industry.
13. We may place the consent application before CAC for further decision.

HOD Remarks :

- Applied for Consent to **Establish for Expansion.**
- Existing consent is granted for All Weather Green Field Port Facility for Solid Cargo Handling with **Coal Handling.** Proposed to **expand activity of Multi Cargo Handling,** Transporting, Stacking & Storage of Iron & Steel, Fertilizer, Lime Stone, Iron Ore, Bauxite, Coke, Raw Sugar, Cement & Clinker, Automobiles, Edible Oil, Ethanol.
- Earlier consent valid upto 31/03/2014.
- Applied for EC for Expansion.
- Existing Phase-I is having EC
- Industrial effluent is Nil for Existing and Expansion.
- Water sprinkling arrangement is provided to Coal handling system at different locations viz. coal unloader machine, all transfer towers, Stacker cum reclaimers and coal stackyard.
- Propose to provide Water sprinkling arrangement for new expansion at different locations.
- Provided 3 no. of Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station at (a) Within Port Area (b) Jaigad village & (c) Nandivade village.
- Submitted Environment Audit Statement for the period of 2010-2011.
- Cess returns submitted upto Dec-2011 and paid upto Oct-2011.
- It is reported by SRO that industry have complied with Proposed Directions dated 19/4/2011 issued by RO, except internal metalled roads, which will be completed before coming monsoon.
- Paid fees of Rs. 3288300/- as per new fees G.R. dtd 25/8/2011.
- SRO recommended the grant of Consent to Establish for Expansion subject to condition that industry shall obtain EC & clearance from MCZMA.
- **The case was discussed in CAC dated 31/1/2012, it was decided to grant the consent to establish for expansion subject to EC/ MCZMA clearance.**
- **Case is again examined in light of Moratorium issued by MoEF vide 16/08/2010, for Ratnagiri & Sindhudurg district.**
- **Industry has submitted the minutes of EAC held on 18-20 Aug-2010 at New Delhi, but copy of T.O.R. is not submitted.**
- **In view of Moratorium issued by MoEF and TOR not yet issued to industry by MoEF, the case for consent to Establish for expansion may be considered only after withdrawal of Moratorium.**
- We may place the consent application before CAC for further consideration.

CAC Item No. 06

HOD Remarks :

- In CAC meeting dated 5/12/2011, it was decided to refuse the case.
- Refusal order dated 20/12/2011, was issued to industry.
- Industry submitted their representation vide letter dated 22/12/2011 and the case was again discussed in CAC meeting dated 10/1/2012.
- It was decided to grant the consent to establish and operate for expansion with amalgamation of existing consent.
- Accordingly consent was issued vide consent order dated 20/01/2012, for the period upto 28/02/2014 after deducting fees of 1 year towards refusal of consent.
- Industry submitted request letter dated 30/1/2012 and requested not to deduct the consent fees towards refusal & extend the consent validity period.
- We may place the request letter & consent application of industry before CAC for further decision in the matter.

CAC Item No. 07

Name of the Industry: M/s. B.S.Ispat (Coal based Thermal Power Plant),
Vill-Sakharwahi, Tehsil & Dist Chandrapur.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for grant of **consent to establish for 150 MW coal based Power plant.**
2. Earlier the case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 10.1.2012 and approved the consent to establish up to COU with the conditions that applicant shall not take any effective steps before obtaining EC as per EIA notification 2006 & amendment thereto and industry shall provide ESP to achieve TPM standard as 50 mg/Nm³ as per the undertaking given by industry.
3. However, industry has not submitted the difference in consent fees of Rs.8,04,380 /- as per new consent fee circular dated 25.8.2011. Board has communicated industry to submit the requisite consent fees. Also Board has issued show cause notice to the industry vide letter dated 31.1.2012 due to non submission of consent fees.
4. Industry vide letter dated 31.1.2012 requested one month time for submission of consent fees.
5. Industry vide letter dated 9.1.2012 submitted the requisite consent fees.

As the industry has submitted the requisite consent fees and as per the decision taken in the CAC meeting held on 10.1.2012 consent to establish may grant.

CAC Item No. 08

Name of the Industry: M/s. Sunflag Iron Steel Co. Ltd.,
Vill- Eklari, Tal- Mohadi, Dist- Bhandara

HOD Remarks:

1. The application for renewal of consent of the main plant of M/s Sunflag Iron Steel Co. Ltd., Vill- Eklari, Tal- Mohadi, Dist- Bhandara was discussed in the CAC meeting held on 05.10.2011 and approved the renewal for the period up to 31.07.2013.
2. The committee pointed that industry has not provided secondary emission control system, on-line monitoring system for stack emission, proper ETP, etc. and it was found that it is continuously non-complying unit after issuing several directions. Hence, it was decided to obtain BG of Rs. 2 Crs. to ensure the provision of necessary pollution control system within 9 months period.
3. As per the decision taken in the CAC meeting held on 5.10.2011, the consent has been renewed up to 31.07.2013 with the condition that unit shall complete the work & commissioning of secondary emission control system on or before 30.6.2012, to install online stack monitoring up to 31.3.2012 & CAAQMS -2 Nos up to 31.3.2012 & industry shall submit the BG of Rs.2.0/- crore.
4. Industry vide letter dated 20.10.2011 requested to waive off the BG of Rs.2.0/- crores

Monitoring results of AAQM and Stack monitoring are exceeding most of the time. Industry has not complied with the consent conditions and directions issued by the Board.

Due to non compliance, the case is submitted for further decision as directed before CAC.

HOD Remarks :

- Applied for consent to operate (Renewal).
- Application received at SRO on 14/11/2011 and at HQ on 23.01.2012.
- As per the C.A certificate submitted the Gross Capital Investment of the Industry is Rs. 333.62 Crore.
- Industrial effluent generation is 3551 CMD & Domestic effluent generation is 250 CMD
- Industry has provided primary, secondary treatment ETP for treatment of Industrial effluent.
- The treated effluent is used for gardening/irrigation.
- No increase in effluent & Production.
- The application was discussed in CAC meeting Dt. 31/01/2012 and the case was deferred and it was decided to resubmit the case in next CAC after obtaining justification for expansion activity whether Consent to Establish has been obtained or not.
- Industry was having consent to Operate no. BO/WPAE/EIC-PN-1391-06/pune-990, dt. 11/12/2006 for 11 Nos. of products valid upto 31/12/2011.
- Further industry has obtained C to E for additional and expansion (7 nos.) of products vide consent no. MPCB/PCI-III/EIC-PN-2889-09/47, dt. 24/06/2009.
- Then Industry has obtained C to O with amalgamation of above two consents Vide consent No. BO/PCI-III/EIC-PN-4471-09/52 Dt.06/03/2010 and was valid upto 31/12/2011, for C.I of Rs. 143.82 Crores.
- In view Gross Block Investment submitted by the industry since commissioning of the unit , SRO office has calculated fees of Rs. 28,35,400/-. Industry has paid difference fees.
- We may consider the application for grant of Renewal.
- The C.I of the Industry has considered earlier based on Net Block Investment, after query it has clarified and obtained revised fees based on basis of Gross Block Investment.
- JVS are not meeting with consented standards.
- BG of Rs. 5.0 Lakhs may be imposed for O & M of ETP.

HOD Remarks:

- 1) Application for renewal with enhanced capacity
- 2) This is Tyre Manufacturing industry.
- 3) Application received at RO on C to E-10/08/2011, C to R with enhanced capacity- 15/12/2011 and at HQ on 05/12/2011 & 13/01/2012 respectively.
- 3) Industrial effluent generation will be 220.0 CMD after expansion.
- 4) RO has recommended the renewal enhanced capacity
- 5) JVS results are within limit.
- 6) Tyre manufacturing industry.

7) **CAC, Approved Renewal (Expansion) in CAC meeting held on 31/01/2012 with following condition:-**

Industry has started expansion without obtaining consent from the Board.

Hence, it was decided to obtain a resolution from Company's Board that they have started expansion activity without obtaining permission from the Board and violated the provisions of Environmental Laws and in future, they will not do such violations.

It was decided to grant consent with the following conditions;

If industry authority fails to submit the above said resolution within one month period, consent will be treated as cancelled.

Obtain BG of Rs. 10 Lakhs to comply consent conditions.

- 8) Industry vide letter dtd-03/02/2012 has submitted that they have not started the expansion activity and submitted the production figures from Jan-2011 to Dec-2011. The production is observed within the previous consented limits (84 MT/day).
- 9) Industry has also submitted the water consumption figures from Jan-2011 to Dec-2011 which are observed within consented limits (960m³/day).
- 10) Further industry has requested to return B.G of 5 lakhs submitted for installation of wet scrubber as per previous consent condition, as they have stopped the use of petcock as fuel and now uses Indian Coal for which they have provided Dust collector.
- 11) Industry has requested to verify above facts from local office.
- 12) Industry has requested to grant consent without any B.G.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for Renewal of consent to operate.
2. Application for grant of renewal of consent to operate received to HQ on 31.01.2012.
3. Analysis results of JVS of effluent samples, parameters are within the consented limits.
4. Industry has paid water cess up 31.05.2011.
5. Industry has submitted environmental statements for the period 2010-2011.
6. Industry has paid consent fees Rs.38,99,190/- For 3 years period as per revised G.R.25.08.2011.
7. RO-Navi Mumbai, has recommended case for grant of renewal of consent to operate for 3 years period (31.01.2015) with necessary changes i.e. Change in name ,incorporation of name of by product and effluent qty.
8. Recommended for grant of renewal of consent up to 31.01.2015.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for 1st consent to operate for expansion except producer gas plant.
2. Industry has obtained Consent to Establish for expansion vide letter dated 08.04.2011 for rolled steel products and producer gas plant.
3. Capital investment of the industry is Rs.253.06 Crores. Consent fee of Rs.10,12,340 paid for the period up to 28.2.2014.
4. Industry has obtained consent to operate for existing steel plant vide letter dated 18.10.2011 valid up to 31.7.2013.
5. Industry has obtained Environment Clearance from MoEF, GOI, New Delhi vide letter dated 26.2.2006. Also submitted the letter of recommendation of Expert Appraisal Committee dated 12.01.2012 (copy enclosed).
6. Industry has installed additional rolling mill within existing set up of the plant without increase in production capacity.

The industry has not complied with the directions issued by the Board and also not submitted the Bank Guarantee of Rs.2.0 Crores as per consent condition of existing unit. The ambient analysis results of ambient air monitoring and stack monitoring are exceeding the standards.

In view of above we may consider the consent application only after installation of requisite pollution control system i.e. secondary emission pollution control system with Bank Guarantee of Rs.2.0 Crores, of the existing plant. (The above plant is located in the same premises).

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for renewal of Consent.
2. Earlier consent for the manufacturing of Gold Bars, Pendants, Medalians – 18.08 MT/Month & Silver Bars, Coins, Grain Articles – 18.08 MT/Month was valid up to 31.12.2011.
3. Capital investment of the industry is Rs.351.83 Crores. Consent fee of Rs.7,03,778/- paid as per new consent fee circular dated 25.08.2011 for the consent validity up to 31.12.2012. Industry has yet not started the manufacturing activity .
