Industry vide letter no. Nil, dated Nil, received on 6.8.2013 has submitted compliance of above requirement mentioning 1. that they are in process to finalise vendors for Co-gen & details will be submitted to MPCB as soon as the procedure is done 2. on the basis of 225CMD of effluent ETP of 250 CMD is redesigned and details of the same submitted 3. Industry has submitted details of fuel consumption. In view of above, it was decided to grant consent to establish for Sugar (3500 TCD) & Co-Gen (14.9 MW) subject to the condition that the capacity of Co-gen above 15 MW and auxiliary fuel consumption above 15% shall require prior EC from competent authority. It was also noted that some of the units of proposed, the ETP seems to be oversized. It was decided that double amount of BG as per the matrix	
		for achieving the standards to be obtained while granting C to 1st Operate, in case, the ETP units are not right sized.	

The consents shall be disposed after obtaining requisite consent fees as per GoM, revised fee structure dtd. 25.08.2011 and according to the new industry wise validity period. The balance fees on the part of MPCB, if any, shall be considered at the time of next renewal of consent, which shall be mentioned in the consents to be issued hereafter.
