For truck loading operations, balancing line with gas recovery or treatment system shall be used so as not cause VOC emissions into the atmosphere. 9. PP shall follow all the relevant regulations laid down for LPG storage and handling by 'Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board' and 'The Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organisation (PESO)'. 10. The project authority shall strictly comply with the provision made in manufacture, storage and import of Hazardous chemicals rule, 1989 as amended in 2000 and the Public Liability Insurance act for handling of hazardous chemicals etc. Necessary approvals from Chief controller of explosives, PESO and other authorities must be obtained before commissioning of project. Requisite onsite and offsite disaster management plan shall be prepared and implemented. 11. Industry shall furnish BG of Rs. 5 Lakh towards compliance of the Consent to Establish conditions. 12. PP shall not connect ETP outlet in Local drain.
