Item no. 1 and 3 were discussed in the meeting considering them as government projects, item no.2 was discussed considering resubmission/deferred item and item no. 5 was discussed considering it as Mega project of Economic importance. Remaining items of book-let no.67 could not be discussed due to short of time, the same shall be discussed in next meeting.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

ANNEXURE-I

<u>Minutes of item of M/s. Godavari Biorefineries Ltd., PO Sakarwadi, Tal. Kopargaon, Dist.</u> <u>Amednagar discussed in 28th CAC meeting held on 25.3.2015</u>

- 1. The Committee noted that M/s Godavari Biorefinery is involved in manufacturing of alcohol (distillery) and alcohol based products(chemical plant).
- 2. The CAC noted that the EC is accorded on 25.01.1993 for industrial alcohol, acetaldehyde, acetic acid, fusel oil, Dil. Acetic acid, Melendazole I.P.USP, Tinidazole, Frusemide, Dicyclomine Hydrovhloride DP/USP, Ethyl Acetate and Acetic Anhydride.
- 3. The CAC noted that there are certain deviations in distillery plant and accordingly the CPCB had issued directions vide letter dated 15.02.2011 to the distillery plant for not to start distillery operation without specific permission from the CPCB.
- 4. These deviations have been noticed by Hon'ble NGT and taken cognizance. Having taken cognizance, Hon'ble NGT vide order dated 10.10.2014 asked the M.S.Baroda University to inspect the site for the following points:
 - Compliance of CPCB directions issued on 25.04.2011 w.r.t dismantling of all unlined lagoons/solar evaporation ponds by 30.06.2011, compliance of Hazardous waste Management Rules, 2000 and closure of distillery unit
 - present position of effluent generated, treatment & discharge
 - ground/river water pollution and soil fertility.
- 5. The M.S.Baroda has inspected and submitted their report including conclusions and recommendations dated 13.12.2014.
- 6. CAC noticed that in the report of M.S. Baroda University, none of the comments pertains to 3- Methyl 3-Pentene- One (MPO) plant. It is also mentioned in the report that
 - MPO plant is not yet started the production, effluent of this plant is yet to come for treatment
 - Hon'ble NGT has not granted stay order on MPO plant.
- 7. The industry has complied with conditions of Consent to Establish (change in product-mix) granted on 11.2.2014.

In the view of above, MPO is a part of chemical plant however the plant is still not in operation, existing ETP for the chemical section comprises of primary, secondary and RO system for achieving zero discharge, there is no overall increase in the effluent generation with starting of MPO unit as there is no increase in overall pollution load due to proposed change in product-mix. Therefore it is decided to grant 1st operate (remaining part) for change in product-mix for MPO and C to E and O for addition of three by products i.e. Sodium Sulphate Salt-123.5 MT/M, Perfumary material base - 131.67 MT/M alongwith and amalgamation with existing consent with following conditions

- 1) The consented quantity of acetic acid shall be amended to 598.85 MT/M in the main consent whose application is due for renewal and in process.
- 2) This consent is granted without prejudice to the orders passed or being passed by the Hon'ble NGT, Pune.
- 3) This consent is granted based on the No increase in Pollution Load certificate issued by ICT, Mumbai on 14.10.2014.
- 4) Industry, the by product generator, should ensure that all the vehicles used to transport by-product to the vendor industry to be fitted with web based GPS system to record the origin to destination position and shall self monitor the compliance and submit monthly report to the Board.
- 5) Industry shall obtain affidavit from vendors stating that the by-product purchased from PP is used as raw material in their respective industries.
- 6) Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 2 lakh towards compliance point no. 3 & 4 above.
