The industry shall provide ETP & STP of adequate capacity for the treatment of industrial & domestic effluent respectively. 2. Treated trade effluent shall be 100% recycled/ reused into process, cooling tower. Treated domestic effluent shall be 60% recycled for secondary purposes such as toilet flushing, air conditioning, cooling tower make up,

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					fire-fighting etc. and remaining shall be utilized on land for gardening. 3. The applicant shall provide online CMS for parameters Flow, TSS & BOD at the outlet of STP and connect to MPCB Server. 4. Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 5 Lakh towards compliance of the Consent conditions.

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
