1. Industry has applied for expansion in the production of Seamless Tubes of different diameters – 2000 MT/Month.
2. Capital Investment of the proposed expansion is Rs.17.4 Crores. Capital Investment of existing unit is Rs.94.90 Crores. Total Capital Investment of the industry is Rs.112.3 Crores, hence in the purview of CAC. Consent to Establish fee of Rs.50,000/- is paid by the industry.
3. Existing unit consent for manufacturing of Seamless Metal Tubes of different diameters – 4000 MT/Month is valid up to 31.03.2014.
4. Proposed expansion is in existing unit which is located in MIDC Ahmednagar & about 2.8 km from Sina river, A-II Class.
5. Domestic Effluent-43 CMD, Septic Tank and Soak pit provided. Treated effluent is disposed on land for gardening. Industrial Effluent-24.0 CMD, Primary treatment provided. Treated effluent disposed on land for gardening.
6. SRO Ahmednagar reported that;
 - i) **Industry already completed work of expansion unit last year without obtaining consent from the Board.**
 - ii) ETP Sludge found lying on the ground.
 - iii) Industry has not provided fume extraction system facility & adequate air pollution control equipment to pickling, phosphating Section and Surface treatment plant as per the previous consent granted by the Board.
 - iv) Industry has not provided sampling facility to furnace chimney.
 - v) **Industry is disposing treated effluent on the back side of the ETP towards MIDC road.**
 - vi) Industry has dumped ETP sludge on open land near sludge filter press.
 - vii) Hazardous waste storage was not as per Hazardous Waste Rule.
 - viii) Adequate height of chimney was not provided to fired tagging section.
7. Environment Statement for the period 2010-2011 submitted.
8. Latest analysis result of treated effluent, ambient air quality monitoring & stack monitoring are not furnished.
9. Cess payment details are not furnished.

Discussed in CAC dated 24.09.2012 and it was decided to keep the case in abeyance till the submission of report by R.O. Nashik towards the compliance of directions issued.

Report received from R.O. Nashik. As unit has already carried out expansion and also not provided adequate APC to various units we may refuse the expansion of the unit and forfeit the existing B.G. of Rs.5/- Lakhs and take another B.G. of Rs.10/- Lakhs and direct R.O. Nashik to issue immediate closure order for such non-compliance.

- Additional fees of Rs. 583000/- is to be recovered from industry as per new fees GR.
- We may grant consent to Establish, subject to EC before operate.
- Case was discussed in CAC meeting dated 20/03/2012, it was decided to confirm the earlier decision of CAC meeting dated 14/2/2012 i. e. the consent to be kept in abeyance due to nonpayment of consent fees.
- Prior to this CAC the action was initiated by the way of issuance of aetter and Show Cause Notice dated 21/12/2011 and 13/01/2012 respectively, to the industry for the submission of additional consent fees as per new fees GR dated 25/08/2011.
- Industry submitted their reply vide letter dated 18/01/2012 and stated that they have submitted demand note of additional consent fees for approval to Executive Director, Godavari Marathwada Irrigation Development Corporation, Aurangabad, the Higher Office.
