### ORDER



The Asstt. Public Information Officer had called upon the Appellant on 27.4.2010, further reminder to attend the personal hearing and the Appellant informed that, he is not feeling well; therefore, he will not be able to attend the hearing.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, the First Appellate Authority has decided to send the information received from the Establishment Branch, to the Appellant through speed post. Accordingly, the appellant was informed telephonically.

The Appeal is therefore disposed off.
