


Restaurants are mainly water polluting potential, water pollution score is normalized to 100.

Decision of Categorization committee w.r.t. Restaurants / Floating restaurants :


- The Restaurant activity having overall waste water generation 10 KLD or less than 10 KLD to be categorized under Orange Category.

- This categorization also applicable to floating restaurants at Maharashtra state jurisdiction.


