The consent is valid upto 31/05/2015. The said category is already specified in Orange category at 34 number glue from starch physical mixing. The Board has also granted consent in the orange category.  The industry has submitted that, we have been erroneously classified as industry under Orange category (0-34); glue from starch (physical mixing). However, we do not prepare glue from starch. Since the process involve no use of water or effluent generation or toxic emission, the process to be considered under Green category (G-88).  G-88, manufacturing of starch adhesive (without blending & mixing.)  Pew cot:  The Maharashtra Pollution Control Board has granted consent to establish to manufacture grey point 5,00,000 Lit/Y, under Green category with condition to operate unit for 60 days in a year, as specified by RRZ Committee in their minutes dated 12/11/2012.
				Further, Board has granted to consent to operate upto 31/08/2014 for manufacture of grape wine 5.00,000 Lit./Y. in Red category with the same condition to operate unit for 60 days in a year, as specified by RRZ Committee in their minutes dated 12/11/2012.  Now, industry has requested in their letter dated 10/06/2014

that, consent may be granted under Green category only. During the manufacturing of wine grapes are fermented with desired bacteria after maturation entire stuff is filtered and filtrate mixed with flavor and preservatives and is packed in a bottle. The solid material removed during filtration is sold as cattle feed.

Quantity of effluent is only 2.5 CMD which is easily biodegradable.

Hence, it is recommended to consider said process in Green category (G-89). — New Cont
