

## <u>Procedure for Authorization for Collection, Segregation,</u> <u>Dismantling, Refurbishing and Recycling of E- Waste</u> <u>under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016.</u>


To obtain authorisation for E-Waste Dismantler/ Recycler under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 from the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in accordance with the procedure under sub-rule (3) of rule 13:

Every Dismantler and Refurbisher or Recycler of e-waste shall make an application in Form-4 to the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in accordance with the procedure under the sub-rule (3) of rule 13

The first step for all the above stakeholders is to create Industry Registration ID with Maharashtra Pollution Control Board through MAITRI (Single Window)












After creation of Registration ID the industry/ unit has to apply for authorization under respective Category with necessary documents mentioned alongwith the application.



The provisions under E-Waste (Management ) Rules, 2016 for Authorization for Dismantling or Refurbishing or Recycler of E-Waste and the application form and online portal provided by MPCB are as below:

## **Authorization**

To obtain authorisation for E-Waste Dismantler/ Recycler under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 from the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in accordance with the procedure under sub-rule (3) of rule 13:

Every Dismantler or Recycler of e-waste shall make an application, within a period of one hundred and twenty days starting from the date of coming into force of these rules, in Form-4 in triplicate to the concerned State Pollution Control Board accompanied with a copy of the following documents for the grant or renewal of authorisation, namely:-

- (a) consent to establish granted by the concerned State Pollution Control Board under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, (25 of 1974) and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981(21 of 1981);
- (b) consent to operate granted by the concerned State Pollution Control Board under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, (26 of 1974) and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981(21 of 1981);
- (c) certificate of registration issued by the District Industries Centre or any other government agency authorised in this regard;
- (d) proof of installed capacity of plant and machinery issued by the District Industries Centre or any other government agency authorised in this behalf;

(e) in case of renewal, a certificate of compliance of effluent and emission standards, treatment and disposal of hazardous wastes as applicable from the concerned State Pollution Control Board or any other agency designated for this purpose:

Provided that an application for renewal of authorisation may be made three months before the expiry of such authorisation: Provided further that

On receipt of an application complete in all respects for the authorisation, the State Pollution Control Board may, after such inquiry as it considers necessary, and on being satisfied that the applicant is utilising environmentally sound technologies and possess adequate technical capabilities, requisite facilities and equipment to dismantle or recycle and process e-waste in compliance to the guidelines specified by Central Pollution Control Board from time to time and through site inspection, may grant authorisation within a period of one hundred and twenty days to such applicants stipulating therein necessary conditions as deemed necessary for carrying out safe operations in the authorised place only, which shall be valid for a period of five years subject to such conditions as may be laid down therein.

Provided that in the case of an application for renewal of authorisation, the State Pollution Control Board may, before granting such authorisation, satisfy itself that there has been no violation of the conditions specified in the authorisation earlier granted by it and same shall be recorded in the inspection report.

The authorisation granted by the State Pollution Control Board under sub-rule (3) shall be accompanied by a copy of the field inspection report signed by that Board Officials indicating the adequacy of facilities for collection, segregation dismantling or recycling of E-Waste and compliance to the guidelines or standard operating procedures specified by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.






In case of any discrepancy, MPCB shall communicate the same through the industry documents section, hence applicants are advised to periodically check their Industry Documents section as shown below:





Once the Authorization is issued / cancelled, the status alongwith copy of letter, will be reflected in the Industry's Login ID and on MPCB's website, which is shown below:



As per Rule 3 (vi), industries shall make application for renewal of Authorisation in Form No. 4 before 120 days of its expiry and concerned State pollution control board may renew the Authorisation for the period of 5 years.

Renewal Application complete in all respect shall be disposed off in 120 days from receipt of the application.
