- 1. The Consent to Operate (part) is granted for a period up to 31.01.2017
- The capital investment of the part of project is Rs. 23.25 crs (i.e. Male Beggar home building: 13.5 crs and Female beggars home building: Rs. 9.75 Crs. as per documents/undertaking submitted by PP; whereas total CI of the entire project is Rs. 376.08 crs)
- 3. The Consent to Operate (part) is valid for PWD's Male and Female Beggar Home building of Public Works Department (PWD) (Executive Engineer, Building Construction Division), CTS No. 469 A, Ramakrishna Chemburkar marg, Chembur, Mumbai on total plot area of 1,13,924.20 sq.m. (as per EC) and BUA of 11,265.29 sq.m. (BUA of 6,594 sq.m. for Male Beggar Home building and BUA of 4,671.29 Sq.m. for Female Beggar Home building) out of total construction BUA of 2,43,131.28 sq.m. as per Consent to Establish.

Schedule-I

Terms & conditions for compliance of Water Pollution Control:

1) A] As per your application, presently you have provided septic tank and soak pit for treatment of domestic effluent till the provision of the STP.

The Applicant shall operate the septic tank and soak pit to treat the sewage so as to achieve the following standards prescribed by the Board or under EP Act, 1986 and Rules made there under from time to time, whichever is stringent.

The treated domestic effluent shall be soaked in a soak pit, which shall be got cleaned periodically. Overflow, if any, shall be used on land for gardening / plantation or discharged in to the municipal sewerage system.

B] PP shall submit details of commissioning and operation of STP to treat the sewage generated from the project within 15 days from issue of this consent. After commissioning of STP, PP shall treat the entire sewage generated from project in the STP and operate the sewage treatment plant (STP) to treat the sewage so as to achieve the following standards prescribed by the Board or under EP Act, 1986 and Rules made there under from time to time, whichever is stringent.

The treated effluent shall be 60% recycled for secondary purposes such as toilet flushing, air conditioning, firefighting, Agriculture, on land for gardening etc and remaining shall be discharged in to the municipal sewerage system.

- 2) The Board reserves its rights to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of waterworks for the purification thereof & the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions. The Applicant shall obtain prior consent of the Board to take steps to establish the unit or establish any treatment and disposal system or and extension or addition thereto.
- 3) The industry shall ensure replacement of pollution control system or its parts after expiry of its expected life as defined by manufacturer so as to ensure the compliance of standards and safety of the operation thereof.
- 4) The Applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 and as amended, by installing water meters, filing water cess returns in Form-I and other provisions as contained in the said act.

General Conditions:

- 1) The applicant shall provide facility for collection of samples of sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
- 2) The firm shall strictly comply with the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and environmental protection Act 1986 and Municipal Solid Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 2000 and E-Waste (Management & Handling Rule 2011.
- 3) Drainage system shall be provided for collection of sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No sewage shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the terminal manholes. No sewage shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
- 4) Vehicles hired for bringing construction material to the site should be in good condition and should conform to applicable air and noise emission standards and should be operated only during non-peak hours.
- 5) Conditions for D.G. Set
 - a) Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by providing an acoustic enclosure or by treating the room acoustically.
 - b) Applicant should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
 - Applicant shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises in respect of noise to less than 55 dB(A) during day time and 45 dB(A) during the night time. Day time is reckoned between 6 a.m. to 10 p.m and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m to 6 a.m.
 - d) Applicant should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside their premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper sitting and control measures.
 - e) Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.
 - f) A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.
 - g) D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
 - h) The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.
 - The applicant shall comply with the notification of MoEF dated 17.05.2002 regarding noise limit for generator sets run with diesel.
- 6) Solid Waste The applicant shall provide onsite municipal solid waste processing system & shall comply with Municipal Solid Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 2000 & E-Waste (M & H) Rule 2011.
- Affidavit undertaking in respect of no change in the status of consent conditions and compliance of the consent conditions the draft can be downloaded from the official web site of the MPCB.
- 8) Applicant shall submit official e-mail address and any change will be duly informed to the MPCB.
- 9) The treated sewage shall be disinfected using suitable disinfection method.
- 10) The firm shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the environment statement report for the financial year ending 31st march in the prescribed Form-V as per the provision of rule 14 of the Environmental (Protection) Second Amended rule 1992.

11) The applicant shall make an application for renewal of the consent at least 60 days before the date of the expiry of the consent. ----0000----- MMM
