5. CONDITIONS UNDER AIR ACT:

The applicant shall install a comprehensive control system consisting of control equipments as is warranted with reference to generation of emission and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the level of pollutants to the following standards:

The applicant shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall (iii) be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. vents attached to various sources of emission shall contenigns. numbers such as S-1, S-2, stc. and these shall be particularly facilitate identification. MUMBAI

(iv) The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise to less than 75 dB(A) during day time and 70 dB(A) during night time. Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

(vi)Other Conditions:

1) The industry should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area.

2) The industry should monitor stack emission & ambient air quality regularly.

3) The industry should comply with Bombay Smoke Nuisance Act, 1912.

7. CONDITIONS UNDER HAZARDOUS WASTE (MANAGEMENT, HANDLING & TRANSBOUNDRY MOVEMENT) RULES, 2008:

The Industry shall not generate any type of hazardous waste.

8. Industry shall comply with following additional conditions:

i. The applicant shall maintain good housekeeping and take adequate measures for control of pollution from all sources so as not to cause nuisance to surrounding area / inhabitants.

ii. The applicant shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green

coverage/ tree plantation.

iii. Solid waste – The non hazardous solid waste arising in the factory premises, sweepings, etc., be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal to dumping ground.

iv. The applicant shall provide for an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed by the applicant to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms

& conditions of this consent regarding pollution levels.

v. The applicant shall not change or alter quantity, quality, the rate of discharge, temperature or the mode of the effluent / emissions or hazardous wastes or control equipments provided for without previous written permission of the Board.

vi. The applicant shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous wastes to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board

for the services rendered in this behalf.

Vii. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of the consent at least 60

days before the date of the expiry of the consent.

viii. The firm shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as pre the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992.

ix. As inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers

during their visit to the applicant.

x. The applicant shall install a separate electric meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.

Xi. Separate drainage system shall be provided for collection of trade and severe effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of collection system in the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in

the pipes / sewers down- stream of theterminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collectionSystem.

xii. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the factory.

- 9. Board reserves right of revoke, suspend or amend the consent issued.
- 10. The consent should not be construed as any exemption from obtaining necessary NOC from other Govt. agencies as may deemed fit necessary.
- 11. The Capital investment of the industry is Rs.8.00 Lacs.
