- **Capital investment Distillery 8.03 crores ,Sugar 18.01 Crores,.Total C.I.of industry 26.04 crores**
- Previous consent was valid till 31/12/2007. Subsequently ind applied for renewal of Consent which was recommended for refusal of Consent by SRO. .
- Industrial effluent generated **230 CMD.**
- Provided Reboiler as treatment system. Treated effluent is used on land for gardening.
- RO & SRO reported that industry is not complied with CREP norms. Not provided 30 days storage tank. Only provided 45 days shahabadi lagoon.
- Industry has leveled 8 acres of compost land.
- Ind has not paid lapse consent fees of rs 5,000/- despite of letter issued by SRO Latur.
- AS industry is not complied RO & SRO Recommended for refusal of Consent.
- Application was discussed in CC dtd 30.05.2012SCN was issued on 18.06.2012.
- Reply from Ind, RO/SRO not received.
- We may refuse consent.

- SRO Sangali has reported that industry has done up-gradation of the existing ETP by,
- Adding new equalization tank.
- Install new blower and distribution network
- Changed media of Pressure Sand Filter and Activated Carbon Filter in tertiary treatment.
- Industry has done modification in primary Treatment.
- Housekeeping in and around the ETP has improved.
- The treated effluent is disposed on its own land of 4 acres for irrigation.SRO further reported that it will achieve the consented norms if operate properly.
- Industry has submitted effluent analysis report which is within consented limit.
- SRO has reported that industry has submitted additional fees of Rs. 2,25,000/- for the grant of consent period up to 31.12.2015 vide letter no MPCB/SRS/TB/2787/12 dt. 12.11.2012
- As per SRO report dt. 28.11.2012 industry has modified existing ETP and improved housekeeping
- Samples ETP inlet outlet has been collected and submitted to Regional Laboratory Chiplun,
- The recent JVS are collected and results awaited.
- Industry has carried modification in existing ETP.
- Based on earlier report recommended to refuse the consent.



2. In its reply to SCN, Industry vide their letter dated 23.11.2012 requested to allow them to operate with existing treatment facilities after painting/refurbishing for the sake of dependent 400 nos of existing employees. Also, they have requested to allow them to transfer concentration streams of the effluent to their other plant or CETP for further treatment and give 2 to 3 years time period for installation of full fledged treatment facilities.
3. Industry has requested to allow continue the office operations and other activities such as store, security post, raw material and finished product store yard as these do not otherwise generate effluent
4. Renewal of consent to operate may be refused and closure direction may be issued.

As stated by Company vide letter dated 6.11.2012 the work of pollution control system will be completed by March, 2013 and hence it will be appropriate if we can consider the consent to Operate (1<sup>st</sup>) only after completion of all related pollution control system and getting compliance from RO/SRO. Till that time application may be kept in abeyance.
