6	Jindal Saw Ltd., (unit-II), Gat No. 161, Nr MIDC, Vill- Malegaon, Tal- Sinnar, Dist - Nashik	Approved 1st Operate	28.02.2015	JD(APC)	<p>Industry has made representation to wave the condition of ARP due to following reason:</p> <p>(a) The concentration of acid used in bath for pickling activity is less i.e. about 6 % and quantity is only 4 to 5.5 kl.</p> <p>(b) They have carried feasibility study of ARP on pilot plant and as per study report ARP system is not suitable and feasible for their plant because concentration of acid reach up to only 10% after recovery and if it is reused in process product quality is affected.</p> <p>Industry has assured to treat the trade effluent generated from process as well as the spent acid and 100% recycle in the process to achieve zero discharge.</p> <p>In view of above it was decided to grant 1st consent to operate with following conditions:</p> <p>(i) Trade effluent shall be from process as well as the spent acid and 100% recycle in the process to achieve zero discharge.</p> <p>(ii) Industry shall submit affidavit that in future if any ARP common facility is commissioned in nearby area they will send there spent acid to the facility for further recovery and sale.</p> <p>(iii) Industry shall submit Bank Guarantee of Rs. 25 lakh valid up to 30.06.2015 and monthly monitoring by SRO, Nashik for next 6 months should be put up before CC.</p>
