## MAHARASHTRA POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD



Minutes of the  $2^{nd}$  Consent Committee Meeting of 2012 held on 03.04.2012 at 15.00 Hrs. in Conference Hall,  $4^{th}$  floor, Kalpataru Point, Sion, Mumbai.

## General Points:

- 1. All the consents shall be issued only after obtaining requisite consent fees, as per the G.R. of Envt. Dept., GoM for revised consent fees dtd. 25.08.2011.
- 2. Committee decided to issue directives to ROs and SROs to carry out survey of STPs provided by local body in operation in their respective jurisdiction regarding number of STPs running at full capacity, quantity of effluent generated in respective area, qty of effluent flowing through pipeline and actual pumped to STP and total qty of effluent actually receiving treatment. The said survey shall be undertaken under the co-ordination of I/C. JD(WPC) / RO(HQ) and shall be submitted to Member Secretary within two months.
- 3. The Consent Committee meeting held on 02.04.2012 shall be considered and read as 1<sup>st</sup> Consent Committee meeting of 2012 instead of 22<sup>nd</sup> consent committee meeting for the convenience of preparing of Statistical Information.
