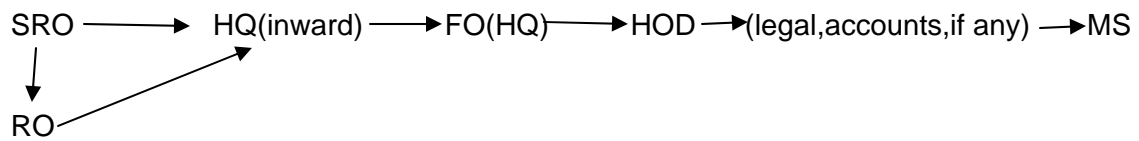

General Points:

1. All the consents shall be issued only after obtaining requisite consent fees, as per the G.R. of Env. Dept., GoM for revised consent fees dtd. 25.08.2011.
2. It was observed that the application under the purview of Consent Committee are being delayed beyond the prescribed limits, due to whatsoever reason, hence it was decided to follow timeline of proposals from the initial stage i.e. receiving to final stage i.e. granting. And directed AS(T) to put up a circular to all ROs/ SROs that all the applications shall be processed and forwarded further within prescribed time period and any inordinate delay at their end shall be taken seriously. The Field Officer's at HQ shall mention the date of initial stage upto final stage (Time period with hierarchy as below)



3. It was also observed that due to the delay in grant of consents many applications for consent to establish attracts the provisions of “Deemed Consent”. Hence, it was decided to encourage such cases in which the project proponent explores the deemed consent.

4. JD(PAMS) suggested that Web Agenda, Minutes and Action Taken Report of CC meetings should be displayed on the Website and all the agendas should also be accompanied by JVS result sheet duly signed by RO/SRO or HOD, similar to CAC practice. Committee agreed on the same.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.

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
