Committee also noted that, the Board has granted Consent to Operate on 27/7/2021 in which Silicon Dioxide (SiO2)-70 MT/M, Sodium Hypochlorite (NaOCI)-60 MT/M & Salt-600 MT/M are shown in by-products.  Committee further noted that, the said application was discussed before Committee on 12/8/2022 & 15/12/2022 and committee deliberated as:  The committee considered only two products i.e. SiO2 & Dil. Sulphuric Acid subjected to joint collection of samples by one of the institutions from IIT, NCL OR NEERI and certification of them.  NERRI report furnished which shows no impurities found.  Sodium Hypochlorite & salt generated from MEE is not considered as by-product. The committee is of the opinion that this is generated from the pollution control system.  The industry is manufacturing inorganic products, hence, EC is not applicable to the unit as per EIA & also the by-products not listed in the Schedule-I of the H&OW Rule 2016.  Committee further noted that, the By-product committee decided to consider the case for-  incorporation of the by-products i.e. SiO2 & Dil. Sulphuric Acid into the existing Consent to operate as the material is not intended to be produced in production process, by obtaining |
