Scope of work: 1.

- The study shall be carried out as per the CPCB's terms of references dtd. 25 June 1.1 2013. You shall assess pollution sources and estimate pollution load on Krishna river water from Rethare weir to Rajapur Bandhara, Shirol, Sangli. The report shall cover location of cities and towns etc. on the bank of polluted river water stretch, industrial pollution, domestic pollution and assess the river water quality, flow etc. related with the river water pollution. You shall also suggest/recommend possible remedies (ETPs/STPs etc.) necessary for abatement of pollution.
- You shall monitor river water quality U/S and D/S of towns and confluence of any 1.2. major tributary rivers with river Krishna.
- All the logistic support required for work will be your responsibility. 1.3
- The analysis of the samples should be carried out from MoEF approved 1.4 laboratories.
- All the chemicals, stationery etc. required for this comprehensive study will be 1.5 procured by you on your own.

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1.6. You may avail secondary data available with the MPCB for your reference which will be provided by the Board.

2. Time frame

- 2.1 You shall submit interim report within a period of three months from the date of issuance of this work order with primary analysis, maps, locations and the probable reasons for causing river pollution.
- 2.2 The final report shall be submitted within six months period from the date of issuance of the work order.

3. Terms of payment

- a. 40% of the total cost of the project will be paid after 15 days of acceptance of the work order.
- b. 30% of the total cost of the project will be paid after submission of interim report and
- c. remaining 30% will be paid after submission of final report and acceptance of the same by the Board.

4. Other conditions
