#### Preamble:-

M/s. WCL Pauni-II Expansion Opencast Mines, WCL Ballarpur Area has applied for Environmental Clearance to the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, New Delhi for proposed project of Coal Mine, Village Sakhari, Tal. Rajura, Dist. Chandrapur for Expansion in production capacity of 0.60 MTPA to 3.25 MTPA (Million Tonnes Per Annum) from 316.30 Ha to 1152.66 Ha. The matter regarding same was discussed in Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) in the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (IA-II (Coal Mining) Division, New Delhi in its 6th meeting held on 27-28 February, 2017. The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the said project has been approved in the meeting dated 27-28 February, 2017 copy enclosed herewith as annexure-I. It has been mentioned in the said TOR that public hearing issues raised and commitments made by the project proponent on the same shall be included separately in EIA/EMP report.

Accordingly, project proponent had submitted an application to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) for conducting Public Hearing as per the provisions of EIA Notification -2006 and TOR issued by Govt. of India. In this connection, MPC Board decided to hold public hearing in respect of the said project on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2017 in consultation with District Collector, Chandrapur. However, due to some untoward reason, this scheduled hearing has been postponed & informed to the concern by publishing a public notice on 03/11/2017 in leading newspapers. Again, project proponent had submitted an application to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) for conducting Public Hearing as per the provisions of EIA Notification -2006 and TOR issued by Govt. of India. In this connection, MPC Board decided to hold public hearing in respect of the said project on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 in consultation with District Collector, Chandrapur. Maharashtra Pollution Control Board has published public notices in Marathi newspaper namely "Lokmat" & "Loksatta" and English newspaper "The Hitvada" on dated 30/10/2018. The appeal was



made to the concerned to submit objections, suggestions, complaints, comments, if any, in respect of the said project to concerned regulatory authorities.

Cotton is a main crop in Vidarbha Region. Due to dust generation from coal mining activities like excavation, transportation of coal & overburden, quality of cotton gets affected thereby causing loss to the farmers. Due to this photosysthesis, pollination & flowering process of crops are affected & approximately 40% of crops are damaged. As per the survey conducted by Govt. Authorities, there is a decrease in production quantity by approximately 50%. The efforts taken by M/s. WCL to control dust emissions seems to be inadequate. Hence, M/s. WCL shall encourage the farmers to change crop pattern and carry out tree plantation on large scale, water sprinkling arrangements, etc. Also WCL shall prepare a policy regarding giving compensation to the affected farmers at the end of survey.

The Chairman of the Public Hearing called upon the people present if there are any other question /issues, the same may be asked. However, nobody came with any question, announced that copy of the proceedings and CD of the public hearing will be made available in due course of time in MPCB office at Regional Office, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, First Floor, Udyog Bhavan, Opposite Bus-Stand, Railway Station Road, Chandrapur.
