Mr. Pranav Pakhale, Sub Regional Officer, MPCB, Dhule and Convener of the Public Hearing Committee welcome the Hon'ble Chairman of the Public Hearing Panel, officials, public representatives and public who were present and with the permission of the Chairperson of the Public Hearing Committee he gave information in brief about the said proposed project of molasses / grain based distillery of 105 KLPD in respect of M/s. Agromark Foods Pvt. Ltd., Gat No. 502/1/A, 502/1/B & 505, Bhadane, Tal. & Dist. Dhule, Maharashtra.

He informed that, as per the EIA Notification of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, (i.e. MoEFCC, GoI) dated 14th September, 2006 as amended on 1st December, 2009, it is mandatory to conduct prior public hearing to certain projects which are covered in the Schedule of the said Notification and this unit is also comes under the purview of this Notification.

The Project Proponent has applied to the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board for conducting the environmental public hearing for proposed project of molasses / grain-based distillery of 105 KLPD. As per the said Notification, one month advance public notice was published in the local newspapers in "Daily Lokmat" for Marathi and in national newspaper "The Times of India" for English on 22thJuly 2022. The public were appealed to send their suggestions or objections regarding the project.

The Convener further informed that, the aim of conducting public hearing is to make aware local people who can be participated in the hearing and they should know the activity to be carried out in the proposed project of molasses / grain-based distillery of 105 KLPD in respect of M/s. Agromark Foods Pvt. Ltd., Gat No. 502/1/A, 502/1/B & 505, Bhadane, Tal. & Dist. Dhule, Maharashtra.

Representative of M/s.Technogreen Environmental Solutions, Pune, Maharashtra has given information in brief along with presentation on various environmental aspects i.e. Environment Impact Assessment and intention behind arranging the Public Hearing, Details about the Project, Project Plan, Environment Status, Details of local Environment and surrounding environment information, Locations of the study area, Air quality in the study area, Noise levels in the study area, Water quality in the study area, Soil quality in the study area, Bio-diversity, Socio-Economic Environment, Expected impact on the surrounding area, Environment Management Plan, Remedial measures on the various environmental impacts, Social Economic Development Plan under Environmental Responsibility Plan, Budgetary provisions for environmental management, Net gain from the project etc.,

After completion of the presentation, the Sub-Regional Officer, MPCB Dhule & Convener of the Public Hearing Panel appealed to the participants in the said public hearing to give suggestions, views, comments etc., if any? so as to enable to take the note of the same in the proceedings. - To take necessary steps / measures to prevent the air / water / noise pollution due to proposed unit.
- 2. To reuse the treated waste-water in the process and to use minimum fresh water.
- 3. To purchase the raw material i.e. grain from the local farmers.

Further, she informed that,

- The proposed project will help for the generation of employment opportunities and thereby economic growth in the area,
- 2. The local residents will get animal feed & fertilizer.
- Due to generation of the employment opportunities the living standards of the local people will be improved.

Further, she thanks to the entrepreneur for proposing to establish the molasses / grain-based distillery in the interior part of the Dhule District and she also, thanks all the participants i.e. residents, officers / employees working in various offices who have participated in the said public hearing.
