The ground water samples are collected at 08 locations i.e. Gonde, Murbi, Wadiwarhe, Sanjegaon, Mukane, Belgaon, Nandur Vaidya and as per the IS 10500 (2012) methodology, 29 parameters have been analyzed. The TDS content is ranging from 132-415 mg/l., and in all parameters, it is below the acceptable limit. The total hardness is above the acceptable limit in GW2, GW5, GW7 & GW8. Total
	Sub-Regional Officer, MPCB	Nitrogen is found above the acceptable limit in all samples except GW 3.  The water consumption will be increased in
5	Nashik and Convener – To inform the increase of industrial effluent due to increase in production by thrice.	mfg. process. The Jet will be used in mfg. process due to which industrial effluent will be generated in a meager quantity and same will be re-used in the process, hence, the quantity of industrial effluent will not be increased.
6	Sub-Regional Officer, MPCB Nashik and Convener – To inform the fulfillment of Water requirement at present and after expansion.	The water requirement is fulfilled from the borewell in the factory premises. The industry has obtained permission from the CGWA. The industry has fixed water supplier and has agreed to supply the water from his own borewell as per requirements.
