The Environment Public Hearing Meeting for the Proposed Expansion of existing Molasses based Distillery unit from 30 KLPD to 140 KLPD using syrup & molasses along with establishment of proposed 5.4 MW Co-generation power plant for Distillery unit (existing 8 MW TG set at Sugar unit), with increasing the Existing Sugarcane crushing capacity from 2500 TCD to 5000 TCD project by project proponent M/s. Shri. S. M. Kurmude, Sub Regional Officer, M. P. C. Board, Jalna and Convener of Environment Public hearing welcome the Hon'ble Chairman of the Public Hearing Panel, officials, public representatives and public present for the hearing and with the permission of the Chairman of the Public Hearing Committee he gave information in brief about Public Hearing on Environment Subject. He informed that, as per the EIA Notification of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, (i.e. MoEFCC, GoI) dated 14th September, 2006 as amended further, it is mandatory to conduct prior public hearing to certain projects which are covered in the Schedule of the said Notification and this unit comes under the purview of this Notification. The Project Proponent has submitted an application to the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board on 26-09-2023. The public hearing was scheduled on 21-11-2023 time 12.00 p.m. with approval of Hon'ble District Collector Beed. Accordingly notice was published in Daily Times of India (English) & Daily Sakal (Marathi) on dated 18-10-2023. Also the documents pertaining to the summary of the Environmental Assessment Report on the project (in English and Marathi) was made available for study to the interested public in the respective Gram Panchayat offices and other government offices. Accordingly, today's public hearing is being held. A copy of EIA report and executive summery was made available at various Govt. offices as under-

Board Jalna has received one suggestions by Email. Also he informed to the public that, participants can raise their objections, comments etc. in oral or written after presentation the Public Hearing. After that he requested the project consultant to give presentation about the proposed project.

The Representative Dr. Kavita Zog of M/s. Mantras Green Resources Ltd., Nashik has given information in brief along with presentation on various environmental aspects i.e. Environment Impact Assessment and intention behind arranging the Public Hearing, Details about the Project, Project Plan, Environment Status, Details of local Environment and surrounding environment information, Locations of the study area, Air quality in the study area, Noise levels in the study area, Water quality in the study area, Soil quality in the study area, Bio-diversity, Socio-Economic Environment, Expected impact on the surrounding area, Environment Management Plan, Remedial measures on the various environmental impacts, Social Economic Development Plan, Budgetary provisions for environmental management, Net gain from the project etc. The information on the above is recorded in the CD and taken notes in brief in the minutes of the public hearing.

After concluding the power point presentation of said project by the Project Consultant, Shri. S. M. Kurmude, requested to present public to give their suggestions, notes, thoughts, questions, etc. He then informed that this is an environmental public hearing and the questions in the same matter shall be raised from the public.

After that, following suggestions, notes, thoughts, questions, etc. were raised and reply to the same was given by project consultant/proponent.

Also, how many people in our village and locality will be given work due to this new project.	On this Shri. Amarsinh Pandit, Chairman of Industry said that, during the expansion of the factory, the residents of this area have been given work. Also manpower will be required for this new expansion. There is no doubt that jobs will be given to the citizens according to their educational qualifications and preference will be given to the citizens of the surrounding area.
