Convener of the Public Hearing Committee informed that Project Proponent – M/s. Bhor Chemicals & Plastics Pvt. Ltd. to be located at Plot No. 3, Sr. No. 6/1/1, Village Vilholi, Tal. & Dist Nashik, Maharashtra, has submitted application along with EIA / EMP for to conduct the public hearing of proposed Manufacturing of Composite Manufacturing Intermediates project.

Convener of the Public Hearing Committee informed that the aim of conducting prior public consultation is to make aware, local people who can be participant in the hearing and they should know the developmental activities and Environment Management Plan of the project.

Nashik; Environment & Climate Change Department, Govt. of Maharashtra, New Administrative Building, Mantralaya, Mumbai; Head Office, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Nashik; Sub Regional Office, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Nashik; and on the website of MPCB.
