#### Preamble:-

M/s. UltraTech Cement Ltd Unit Manikgarh Cement Unit-I & II, Po. Gadchandur, Tal. Korpana, Dist. Chandrapur has applied for Environmental Clearance to the Environment & Climate Change Department, Govt. of Maharashtra, Mumbai for proposed project of Markagondi Laterite Mine Having Lease Area of 54.25 HA. Production Quantity-7,00,000 TPA Located at Village Markagondi, Tal. Jiwati, Dist. Chandrapur. The matter regarding same was discussed in State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC-1) in the 226th SEAC Meeting held from 25/07/2022 to 27/07/2022 and 252nd meeting of SEIAA dtd. 21/10/2022. The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the said project has been approved in the above-said meeting (copy attached). It has been mentioned in the said TOR that in public hearing the issues raised, and commitments made by the project proponent on the same shall be reported separately.

As per Environmental Impact Assessment Notification, 2006, the environment study should be carried in the radius of 10 km from the project site before environmental public hearing and to include in the final environmental impact assessment report the environmental issues raised by the project affected people about the proposed project. As the proposed project falls under Category B-1, it is mandatory for the Project Proponent to obtain prior Environment Clearance (EC) from Environment & Climate Change Department, Govt. of Maharashtra, Mumbai.

Project Proponent M/s. UltraTech Cement Ltd Unit Manikgarh Cement Works Unit-I & II, Po. Gadchandur, Tal. Korpana, Dist. Chandrapur, Maharashtra, has applied Maharashtra Pollution Control Board on 14/06/2023 for conducting Environment Public Hearing.

District Collector, Chandrapur, Maharashtra State, in co-ordination with MPCB Chandrapur Office, approved to hold a public hearing on 16/02/2024 at 11:00 AM Physical as well as Online Environmental Public

Hearing at Project Site, Vill. Markagondi, Tal. Jivati, Dist. Chandrapur, Maharashtra. The meeting number and password was made available.

As per EIA Notification, 2006, 30 days' advance public notice was published by Sub Regional Office, MPCB Chandrapur in the Local Newspaper in Daily Lokmat, Nagpur Edition for Marathi and in National Newspaper Daily Hitavada for English on 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2024. An appeal was made to residents of the area, environmental organizations, residents to be displaced by the project or residents to be affected by the project in any other way to submit their views, comments, suggestions or objections about the proposed project in writing or by email to the local MPCB Chandrapur office till the date of public hearing.

The public hearing was thus widely publicized following the due procedure as per the Notification, so that it would be convenient for the project affected or concerned persons to register their views, comments, suggestions or objections with the concerned department. As per the directives, the public consultation is arranged on the project site.

#### **MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING:-**

At the beginning of the meeting, Shri Umashankar Bhadule, Sub Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Chandrapur and Convener, Environment Public Hearing Committee welcomed Shri Sanjay Pawar, Additional District Magistrate, Chandrapur and Chairman, Environment Public Hearing Committee; Shri Tanaji Yadav, Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Chandrapur and Member, Environment Public Hearing Committee, Project officials, Journalists, NGOs working in the field of environment and local people who were present in large number and informed all the procedure of the public hearing. He appealed all the participants to raise views, doubts, ideas, suggestions or objections regarding the proposed project in environmental angle only. He said that the public hearing is organized only for the local people and project affected persons, so that the environmental issues and doubts would be resolved.

Convener of the meeting further informed that this meeting is arranged to know the feelings, suggestions or objections of the local people for the proposed project in environmental angle only and this Committee has no right to sanction, reject or recommend the proposed project. The suggestions or objections received during the meeting will be noted and it will be included in the minutes of the meeting in Marathi and in English and it will be submitted alongwith Final EIA report, the written suggestions/objections with the approval of Chairman of the Environment Public Hearing Committee through MPCB Head Office to Environment, Forest & Climate Change Ministry, Govt. of India, New Delhi. An Expert Committee will take further decision accordingly.

Convener of the meeting further informed that as per the provisions of the Notification, the meeting is being photographed and video is being shot and after the presentation, the participants can raise their questions, suggestions, thoughts and objections. The Project Environmental Consultant or Project Proponent will answer the same. While asking questions, first inform your full name and residence village. Thereafter, some persons from public started expressing their views, objections which are as under:-

Chairman, Public Hearing Panel informed that, appropriate answers to all the questions will be given. There are other options available if anybody is not satisfied. All the suggestions & objections will be listened & govt. will take decision. appropriate This committee has no right to take any decision during public hearing.

The EIA report presented during 2 the Public Hearing is false. This report is not verified. We had taken objection on the EIA report. Hon'ble District Collector is the first citizen of a District. An answer is expected from your side on the paper which is misleading the public. I am of the opinion that the said Public hearing is unconstitutional. If a person is constitutionally complaining about a certain issue then it is the duty administration to investigate the complaint & redress complainant. It is the duty of Public Hearing Panel to scrutinize the EIA report. You should have informed me about authentication of the said EIA report as soon as I filed a complaint. A clean environment is the constitutional right of every Indian citizen. Chandrapur district is moving towards extinction.

Chairman, Public Hearing Panel informed that, the points raised by you has been noted. You are requested to allow other persons to present their views about the project. Another chance will be given to raise your issues.

Point regarding filing a complaint against the project is not mentioned in the advertisement. I am working in the sector of Environment through my NGO since 2010. Already there are pollution issues due to existing

- Mitigation measures and Environment management plan for the project during construction phase as well as operation.
- Other details as outlined in the EIA Report.

The truthfulness of air, water & noise monitoring cannot be verified because local people were not taken into confidence while monitoring was being done. The Public Hearing are conducted for the sake of common people. But if the administration is approving the false reports submitted the Project Proponents then there is no big tragedy for Chandrapur District. Pollution is increasing in Chandrapur District day-by-day & it is affected the health of local people & wild animals. overburden Where will be the disposed?

The EIA report presented during the Public Hearing is a draft report. Final EIA report will be prepare after the Public Hearing which will be assessed by the State Level Environment **Impact** Assessment Authority. An expert committee scrutinizes all the impacts in two stages. Environment Clearance granted after receipt of both approval from the stages. The EIA report is not prepared by the Project Proponent. Α separate organization is nominated for preparing EIA report. Nobody has the right to interfere. EIA report is prepared scrupulously following all the rules of govt. Only laterite excavation will be done in this project and there will be no generation of overburden.

As per forest acts & rules, no permission is given to any kind of project in forest area. Then how a Public Hearing is conducted? Local People & residents of this district do not understand this. Local people are present for Public Hearing only for compensation & employment. How the land can be handed over to polluting industries if the problem of livelihood persists? It is the duty of Hon'ble District Collector to protect the health of local people.

An expert committee carries out all types of monitoring. EIA report prepared is by scrupulously following the rules & regulations.

Will you directly provide compensation to the land losers or will you acquire the land through brokers? Because some brokers are doing some kind of transactions with the local farmers since last 2-3 months. They are purchasing the land from local farmers & are giving an amount of Rs. 3.60 Lakhs per acre. The said land is being sold to UltraTech Cement Company. Also, they are taking their commission from the said amount & are misleading the local farmers. Will the company personally purchase the land & provide facilities?

Project Proponent informed that, land will be acquired as per govt. rules & regulations and compensation will be provided accordingly.

Chairman, Public Hearing Panel stopped the people from having conversation between themselves.

Project Proponent informed that, company will purchase land as per govt. rules. The said fraud movements shall be brought to the notice of the Govt./District administration. Company has not appointed any broker for purchase of land.

5 Land brokers from Chandrapur & Gadchandur are trying to purchase the land from local people & sell it to the company. Due to this local people will have to bear the losses.

Public Hearing Chairman, Panel informed that, the Public Hearing is held for discussion of environmental issues. Land acquisition process will be started after Environmental obtaining Clearance.
