According to provisions of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Climate Change, Govt. of India, Environment Impact Assessment Notification dtd. 14.09.2006 and amended thereof the Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation Ltd, have requested Maharashtra Pollution Control Board to conduct public hearing required for Environmental Clearance for proposed construction of Nagpur - Gondia Access Controlled Super Communication Expressway under Package-I starting at Gavasi in Nagpur District and ends at Lodhi Tola in Gondia district (Ch. 0.000 to Ch. 144.807). In addition to the main alignment two feeder routes are included in Package I i.e., Gondia Bypass (Ch. 0.000 to Ch. 13.744) and Tiroda Feeder Route (Ch. 0.000 to Ch. 3.826) and under Package - II construction of Bhandara-Gadchiroli Access Controlled Super Communication Expressway starts Sawarkhedra Interchange of Nagpur-Gondia Expressway to Gadegaon on National Highway NH-53(B) leading to Raipur (Ch. 0.000 to Ch. 24.705) and Borgaon Interchange of Sawarkhedra - Gadegaon (Ch. 0.00 to Ch. 69.536) link to Kinhi village on NH 353D.
