Sub: Delegation of powers about Consent Management in the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.

PREAMBLE:

The Board had issued a detailed office order in respect of delegation of powers about Consent Management in the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board vide office order No.E-25/1998 by the letter No.MPCB/TB/Del-Powers/B-1295, dtd. (9/3/1998) The Board had made necessary amendments in those powers from time to time. The Consent Appraisal Committee in its meeting held on 7/1/2008 has perused and deliberated existing delegation of powers with reference to the increased workload of the Board in respect of Consent Management. The Committee also noted that the functions of the Board have increased manifold and it has become a multi-disciplinary organization. The Board is entrusted with the implementation of a number of Environmental Legislations, such as, Hazardous Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1989 as amended from time to time, Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules 1998, as amended from time to: time, the Recycled Plastics (Manufacture and Usage) Rules, 1999 and the Maharashtra Bio- Degradable Garbage (Control) Ordinance, 2006, Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000 and the Batteries (Management and Handling) Rules, 2001. Recently, the Board is further entrusted with the work of grant of Consent to Establish and Consent to operate to the sand dredging activities. All these regulations, increase the work in respect of consent management by way of adding new responsibilities about grant of authorizations / registrations under the provisions of the above legislations.

The delegation of powers is made mainly with reference to the categories of industries. Now, there has been a large scale increase in industrial activities due to economic development. Due to increased number of activities, the size and capital investment has also gone up. Therefore, broad delegation of powers in respect of consent management is necessitated. On account of increased work-load of
