## **CIRCULAR**

Sub: Sectoral Approach for consent processing.

Ref: Discussions held in CAC meeting dtd 22.03.2013.

The existing consent processing practice i.e. as and when the consent application is received for 1<sup>st</sup> operate and renewal of consent, it is processed and validity period of consent is granted depending on the fees paid by the industry, was discussed in CC /CAC meeting. It is noted that due to this practice the month in which consent validity expires (terminal month) is different for the industries of same type/sector. As a result it becomes difficult to take review /prepare action plan / lay uniform guidelines for the sector as a whole.

After due deliberations, a time table for sectoral approach for processing of applications related to 1<sup>st</sup> operate and renewal of consent so as to have uniformity in terminal month of consent period has been prepared and is enclosed herewith as Annexure I (Summary) & Annexure II (Detailed list). The sectoral approach has been prepared on the basis of the new categorization of industries, circulated by CPCB and adopted by MPCB on 25.06.2012. This circular will be applicable to cases in the purview of CAC/CC/ HOD at HQ.

The consent fees shall be adjusted as per the uniform validity. The additional fees may be recovered on pro-rata/ monthly basis and consent validity shall be given for further period as per revised uniform validity. This circular shall be implemented in good spirit and shall not cause any inconvenience to the project proponent while accepting/processing consent applications. In no case this circular should be used for returning /non-acceptance of application.

This circular shall come into force with immediate effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2013.
