Law Officer (LW) has already communicated the minutes In the said meeting it coordinating meeting held on 05-02-1999. decided that each Field Officer working with Sub-Regional Officer should collect the samples as detailed below:

1) JVS to be collected:

a) from final outlet after treatment 15 of waste water during 5 days 3 b) Hazardous waste

2) Samples of air emissions to be collected during 3 days on field as under:

a) Stack b) Ambient air sample c) Noise level monitoring

3) Environmental sampling for 2 days

Thereafter the Hon'ble Chairman of the Board called the meeting of officers in HQ and took a review of number of industries in each region, the industries from which the cess is being collected and the samples received in the laboratories. The number of Field Officers working in the Board and the number of industries where sumpling is required were considered jointly and after idepth consideration, the Chairman came to conclusion of adopting changed sampling norms which are stated below. that each Field Officer working with Sub-Regional Officer can collect 40 Nos. of samples per month on an average considering his causal leave, earned leave and holidays.

Hence it is now instructed that each Field Officer working Sub-Regional Officer should collect 40 Nos. of samples as stated below instead of 36 as decided earlier.

1) JVS to be collected:

a) from final outlet after treatment 16 of waste water during 5 days b) Hazardous waste

2) Samples of air emissions to be collected during 3 days on field as under :

3 a) Stack b) Ambient air sample 3 c) Noise level monitoring

The help of Field Inspectors and Field Assistants should also be taken while carrying out the sampling.

Secondly, the frequency of sampling issued earlier are also changed as below considering the existing staff available.
